ATTENTION: Prospective Monitors

The State Future Problem Solving Bowl will be held on-campus on **Saturday, April 9**. At this competition qualifying Future Problem Solving teams from across the state will meet to compete for the honor of determining the 3 best teams from across the state. From 8:15-10:15 students will be meeting to solve a futuristic problem using the creative problem solving process. Four member teams will be placed in rooms on east campus for the competition. **Each team must provide an adult monitor in order to compete at the FPS State Bowl on April 9.** You would be assisting us in monitoring the teams to be certain that all of the Future Problem Solving rules are observed. Your role would be to (1) take the teams to their respective rooms, (2) hand the problems to the teams, (3) call for the problems at the end of the two hour period, (4) take the problems to the evaluators. [You will be provided with detailed maps of campus and floor plans of buildings to know where rooms are located.]

There will be a mandatory meeting from 7:15 -7:45 a.m. on April 9 for the monitors to further explain their responsibilities and answer any questions. The opening session is planned for 7:45 am. You will be prepared to monitor at that time. You should be completed with your monitoring responsibilities by 10:30 a.m.

The coach of the team you will be representing will return a Monitor Information Sheet with the Team's Registration Form for the State Bowl by March 9 to the Nebraska FPS Office. You will receive additional information prior to the State Bowl to explain your duties further.
